Your 12 step guide to exporting organic products under the Official Organic Assurance Programme (OOAP)

Step1

Register with an OOAP Third Party Agency (TPA) (AsureQuality or BioGro).

Step 2

Have an organic management plan which has been assessed, evaluated and verified by your TPA that it meets the OOAP Standards.

Step 3

Ensure you are certified to the OOAP markets you export to.

Step 4

Read and understand the requirements of the OOAP Standards: visit MPI's website: www.mpi.govt.nz (click on exporting, then organics, then requirements).

Step 5

Register with MPI as an organic exporter: visit MPI's website: www.mpi.govt.nz (click on exporting, then organics, then forms and template).

Step 6

Notify MPI of an accountable and designated person: visit MPI's website: www.mpi.govt.nz (click on exporting, then organics, then forms and template).

Step 7

Follow the requirements set out in the Organic Overseas Market Access Requirement (OMAR) for the relevant export destination(s): visit MPI's website: www.mpi.govt.nz (click on exporting, then organics, then requirements).

Step 8

Register all export consignments with MPI: visit MPI's website: www.mpi.govt.nz (click on exporting, then organics, then forms and templates).

Step 9

Request the appropriate export certification (consignment documentation): visit MPI's website: www.mpi.govt.nz (click on exporting, then organics, then forms and templates).

Step 10

Provide declarations of free on board (FOB) value when requested by MPI.

Step 11

Pay all MPI fees under the OOAP by the 20th of the month following invoice.

Step 12

Pay Third Party Agency (AsureQuality or BioGro) fees as required.
