

CTO Direction

Equivalent measures for consignment non-compliant with VEHICLE.ALL

CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: 27_CTOPlantsDir2020070

Pursuant to section 27(1) (d) (iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Paul Hallett, give the following direction for measures that differ from those required by section 4.1 in the IHS: Vehicles, Machinery and Parts–VEHICLE.ALL that may be applied to consignment C2019/45433 (consisting of a trailer and machinery exported on a flat rack container (TRIU0739647), for the [REDACTED], is permitted to land in New Zealand under the following conditions:

1. The consignment must be moved directly from the vessel to the fumigation area once it arrives at Port Chalmers; and
2. The consignment must be secured immediately in preparation for treatment; and
3. The consignment must be treated as per Approved Biosecurity Treatment (ABTRT) for BMSB by an approved treatment supplier within 2 hours of discharge from the vessel; and
4. Following treatment, the consignment must be inspected by an MPI Officer to ensure the treatment was effective and that all other requirements of VEHICLE.ALL have been met.

This CTO direction applies to consignment C2019/45433 (consisting of a trailer and machinery) exported on flat rack container (TRIU0739647) only.
